Following the recent Job Task Analysis (JTA) survey, the Commission on Paraoptometric Certification and Professional Testing Corporation developed new paraoptometric examinations for 2021 (CPO, CPOA & CPOT). New content outlines based on the JTA survey results are available in the 2024 Paraoptometric Examination Handbook and EyeLearn. (Note: the CPOC examination was reviewed and revised for 2021 but is still based on ICD-10.)
