# Courses

## SATURDAY

### **8:00 am - 9:40 am - Glaucoma Update - 2 Hours (COPE 57447-GL) - Maria Pribis, O.D.**

This course will review the treatment of open angle glaucoma based on major studies, as well as introduce evidence for new diagnostic tools, medical therapies, and minimally invasive surgeries for the management of glaucoma.

### **10:00 am - 12:00 pm - Dry Eye Update - 2 Hours (COPE 57448-AS) - Maria Pribis, O.D.**

This course reviews the pathophysiology, signs, and treatments of dry eye disease and contributing eyelid disorders. It also introduces clinically relevant findings from the DEWS II report, and new evidence regarding treatments for DED.

### **12:00 pm - 1:00 pm - LUNCH**

### **1:00 pm - 1:50 pm - Pharmacology Review - 1 Hour (COPE 57436-PH) - Maria Pribis, O.D.**

This course reviews common ocular side effects of topical and systemic medications. It also introduces drugs that are currently being studied in clinical trials or recently received FDA approval for the treatment of ocular conditions.

### **2:00 pm - 3:40 pm - OCT, the Macula, and an OCT-A Primer - 2 Hours (COPE 57589-PD) - Maria Pribis, O.D.**

This course reviews the diagnosis of vitreomacular interface disorders using OCT. OCT scans for each VMI disorder are shown. OCT angiography is also introduced, and OCT-A images of common ocular diseases are shown.

### **3:50 pm - 4:40 pm - Macular Degeneration Update - 1 Hour (COPE 57433-PS) - Jordan Keith, O.D.**

This course reviews the pathophysiology, treatment for AMD, and treatments specific for wet AMD, as well as introduces an OCT classification scheme for CNVMs and evidence regarding potential associations between AMD and new risk factors.

## SUNDAY

### **8:00 am - 9:40 am - Retinal Vascular Occlusions Update - 2 Hours (COPE 57406-PS) - Jordan Keith, O.D.**

This course reviews the pathophysiology, signs, symptoms, and treatments of common retinal vascular conditions RVOs, RAOs, OIS, DR, CSCR, as well as reviews new evidence regarding treatment and management of these conditions.

### **10:00 am - 12:00 pm - 2018 Rapid Fire Updates: YAG Vitreolysis, Concussion and Optometry, Plaquenil Guidelines, and Myopia Control - 2 Hours (COPE 57544-GO) - Jordan Keith, O.D.**

This course will discuss YAG vitreolysis, the role of optometrists in managing visual disorders associated with concussions, 2016 Plaquenil® dosing and screening guidelines, and treatments for myopia control.
