Paraoptometric Lifetime Achievement Award Guidelines and Rules

As a means to recognize retired certified paraoptometricians who have served the profession of optometry by continually giving of themselves in areas of patient eye care, office management, mentoring colleagues, and in service to the paraoptometric profession.

Guidelines

Paraoptometricians being considered for this award must have:

- been retired as a paraoptometrician at least two (2) years at the time of the recognition presentation
- been certified at the time of retirement
- been a certified paraoptometrician for a minimum of ten (10) years prior to retirement
- worked as a paraoptometrician for at least fifteen (15) years prior to retirement
- received at least $\frac{3}{4}$ of the vote of approval by the CPC Commissioners present at the time of the vote

Rules

Current AOA Commission on Paraoptometric Certification volunteers are not eligible to be nominated. The nomination must be submitted to the AOA CPC and are accepted for review throughout the year.

The nomination must be submitted by one of the following:

1. A state, regional or local paraoptometric or optometric organization
2. An AOA member optometrist
3. An AOA Associate member paraoptometrician
4. A certified paraoptometrician

When submitting the nomination, it must include the following:

- The nomination must be submitted on the official nomination form.
- Letters of recommendation must be dated within one year of application due date.
- Only single page recommendations will be accepted.
- Ancillary articles and documentation regarding professional service are welcome and will be taken into consideration by the judges.
