Committee	Description
<b>Paraoptometric Resource Center Committee</b>	A committee of the AOA Board of Trustees. Directly influence the education of other paraoptometric by developing rly continuing education plan. Recruit new authors, review education/training materials, and promote awareness. Open to AOA associate members.
<b>CPC Continuing Education Review Committee</b>	Review, grant, or deny approval requests for continuing education courses submitted to the Commission on Paraoptometric Certification (CPC). Review current recertification requirements and make recommendations as needed. Upon completion of the annual assignment, committee members will be awarded up to five (5) continuing education credit hours, based on participation, that can be used toward the requirements for certification renewal. Committee members must hold an active CPC certification.
<b>CPC Certification Examination Committee</b>	Develop, evaluate and review test items according to psychometric standards as provided by the contracted testing company. Upon completion of the annual assignment, committee members will be awarded continuing education credits, based upon participation, that can be used toward the requirements for certification renewal. Committee members must hold an active CPO, CPOA, or CPOT certification.
<b>CPC Coding Certification Examination Committee</b>	Develop, evaluate and review test items according to psychometric standards as provided by the contracted testing company. Upon completion of the annual assignment, committee members will be awarded continuing education credits, based upon participation, that can be used toward the requirements for certification renewal. Committee members must hold an active CPOC, CPO, CPOA, or CPOT certification.
